From 2008 to 2010 pianist in the Vienna Art Orchestra, concerts at international jazz festivals.

Since 1996 piano duo with Veronika Trisko.

Winner of many competitions: International Broadcasting Competition Concertino Praga, Grieg Competition Oslo, Concorso Internazionale Provincia di Caltanissetta, Musica Juventutis and many others.

2010 finalist at ARD-Piano duo Competition in Munich, Special Prize for the best performance of the commissioned work by Minas Borboudakis.
